Hello There: Thank you for your interest in our CNA classes.

Here is some information about our class:

*You will need to be a High School graduate or have your GED – if you do not have either you will be required to take an Ability to Benefit Test prior to taking the class. At this time, GH College has agreed to provide that test for our students.

*You will also need to be able to pass a DSHS background check. We have the forms for you to fill out.

*You need to speak, read & write English (as a 2nd language is ok)

Take our CNA Class and you can choose where you would like to work i.e.

**Hospitals * Rehab * Traveling Agencies * Other Agencies
Skilled Facilities * Home Health Care * Assisted Living**

We have a wonderful instructor, Brenda Lewis, who has been with us since the beginning of the year. She is a very experienced RN who has spent much of her career teaching as well as nursing and is dedicated to helping her students to be successful.

Our class is a 100 + hour class (about 3.5 weeks) - The 1st and 2nd weeks are from 8am to 1pm M-F in McCleary located in Apt #69 (upstairs) at the Beehive Retirement Community – we are on the 7th ST side. The 3rd week we go to clinicals at a nursing home, generally Pacific Care Center in Aberdeen from 6am to 2pm M-F. The 4th week we come back to McCleary Mon, Tue and Wed only from 8am to 1pm.

The cost of this class, including registration, is \$550.00. The books are \$60.00 – this includes the textbook and the workbook. We sell them at our cost plus shipping and handling; the books must be paid for prior to taking home. We also give you a Dementia Care manual – at no charge.

Students will need scrubs and white shoes to wear before Friday of the first week.

You will also need a TB test. You may have it done where you prefer; it is required prior to going to the Nursing Home for clinicals and we will need a copy of the results for our files.

If you don't have a NAR (Nurse's Aide Registered license) you will need to send for it after you have taken the HIV/Aids Ed Class (the 2nd week) – we will provide the applications – it will cost you \$30.00 subject to change.

After receiving your CNA certificate of completion at the end of our course, you may apply to take the State CNA test through NACES which is \$107.00. After passing that test you will be eligible to send for your CNA license.

At times, there are some funds available for assistance with payment: *Nursing Homes reimburse tuition costs when you go to work for them; save your receipts to show them. *Hospitals or other places where employed oftentimes do the same. *Check with granted scholarships or Indian Tribes where applicable. *Workforce sometimes will assist displaced workers when funds are available– you must be eligible for the WIA program and have applied for it and deemed eligible prior to entering training. To make an appointment to determine eligibility - 360-538-2384.

We also are now qualified for the WRT program which assists with tuition for those who are unemployed and receiving employment benefits. Call Annette if you feel you qualify. 360-495-3619

We continuously seek for additional ways for our students to receive funding for our class. If not eligible for assistance, you can pay for our the Class & books by certified check, cash or by going to our website, www.nactrainingprogram.com; there you will click on Pricing/Ordering and pay through PayPal either by credit card or you can have the funds taken directly from your account. Registration fee is paid at time of registration and balance must be paid prior to the 3rd week. Students sometimes place fees on credit card which they pay back when reimbursed by place of employment.

You will receive your CNA certificate after receiving a passing grade in the final test of the class. You will also receive a 7 hour HIV Aids Certificate and a CPR/First Aid Card during the course.

To secure a place in our class, please send the registration form (You can download & print it from the forms page or request us to send you a copy on the contact page) & \$100.00 If Worksource or another organization is paying for your class, just send your form and verification from them of promised payment.
